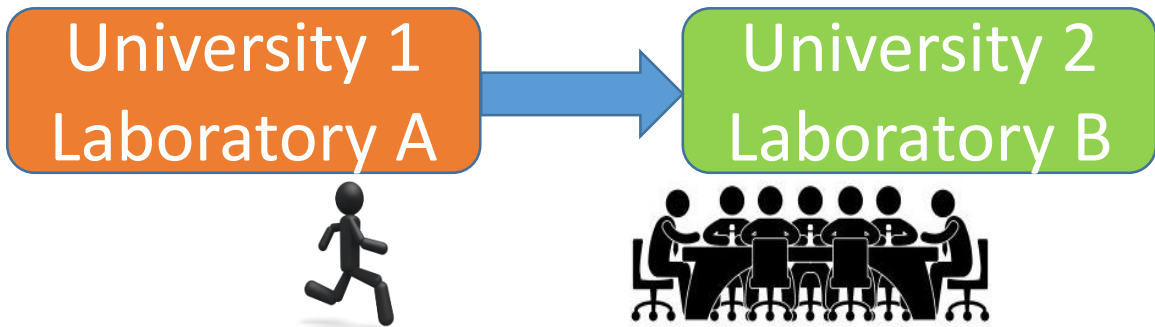




# Super Short Study visit Project for Doctoral Students

## Objectives:

- Promote super-short-term exchange study between Japanese Uni. laboratories for doctoral candidates (some support for transportation expenses provided)
- Networking with other young researchers
- Fusion of different research fields
- Improved research capabilities of young researchers



## Application Procedure & Financial Incentives

- **Target Applicants** : Japanese university doctoral candidates
- **First term** : 1<sup>st</sup> Agt~30<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2014 (Deadline **30<sup>th</sup> Jun.**)
- **Second term**: 1<sup>st</sup> Dec., 2014~31<sup>st</sup> Mar., 2015 (Deadline **31<sup>st</sup> Oct.**)
- **Awards**: 3 students / year (max), **30,000 yen / visit (max)**
- **Application Procedure**: On one A4 page provide personal details of university, affiliation, grade, name, & contact details (phone. no., postal address), and an abstract of your current research (100 words), as well as what you could obtain from the planned study visit (150 words).

On a separate A4 page provide details of your planned visit (length of visit (around 1 week), means of transportation & cost, agenda for visit), and a signed letter of agreement to the visit (incl. email addresses) by the professors of both your home laboratory and that to be visited. After making a PDF file of both documentation, send it to the secretary of '3S' (Hirotaka Naito (Kyoto University)).
