## **Application Procedure & Financial Incentives**

- Target Applicants: Japanese university doctoral candidates
- First term: 1<sup>st</sup> Jul~30<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2015 (Deadline 19<sup>th</sup> Jun.)
- Second term: 1<sup>st</sup> Dec., 2015~31<sup>st</sup> Mar., 2016 (Deadline 31<sup>st</sup> Oct.)
- Awards: 3 students / year (max), 30,000 yen / visit (max)
- Application Procedure: On one A4 page provide <u>personal details</u> of university, affiliation, grade, name, & contact details (phone. no., postal address), and an <u>abstract of your current research</u> (100 words), as well as what you could obtain from the planned study visit (150 words).

On a separate A4 page provide <u>details of your planned visit</u> (length of visit (around 1 week), means of transportation & cost, agenda for visit), and a <u>signed letter of agreement</u> to the visit (incl. email addresses) by the professors of both your home laboratory and that to be visited. After making a PDF file of both documentation, send it to the secretary of '3**S**' (Hirotaka Naito (Kyoto University)).
